The Habitat for Humanity Critical Home Repair program provides major repairs at a discounted rate to keep homeowners safe and warm, and from being displaced from their homes. In addition, our work preserves affordable housing in Seattle and the greater King County.

What repair services are offered?

- Safe access modifications
- Deck and step repair
- Exterior door repair
- Gutter cleaning or repair
- Exterior painting
- Siding repair
- Porch repair
- Fence repair
- Roof repair & replacement
- Other repairs, as needed, concerning the preservation of the home

Habitat Critical Home Repair Does NOT Address

- Emergency repairs
- Cosmetic repairs
- Bathroom & kitchen renovations

How Do I Qualify?



- You plan to continue to use the home as your primary residence for at least one year from the completion of repairs.
- You are willing to partner with Habitat by completing “sweat equity” hours (hours based on type of repair), attending a maintenance class, and raising awareness about Habitat.
- You own and live in an insured home in our service area: (See maps on reverse side)
- You agree to a payment plan based on your income.
- You meet the household gross income requirement:

3 person.....	\$6,020	6 person.....	\$7,758



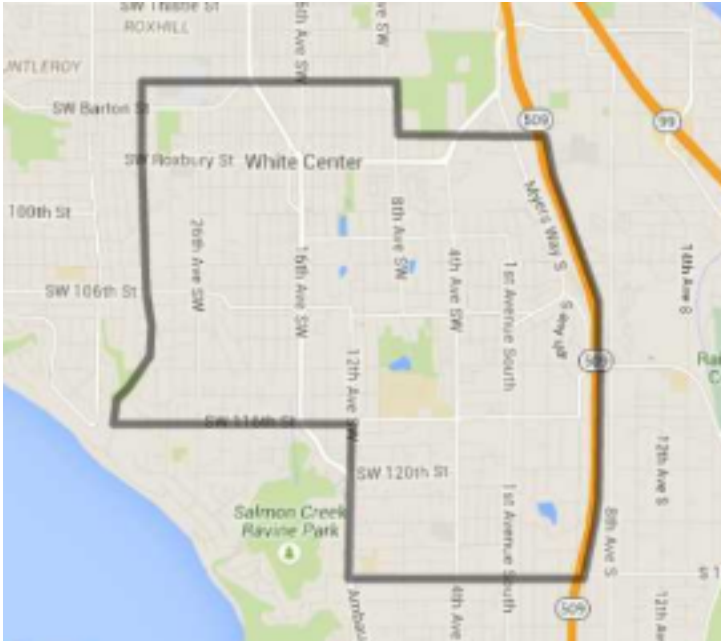

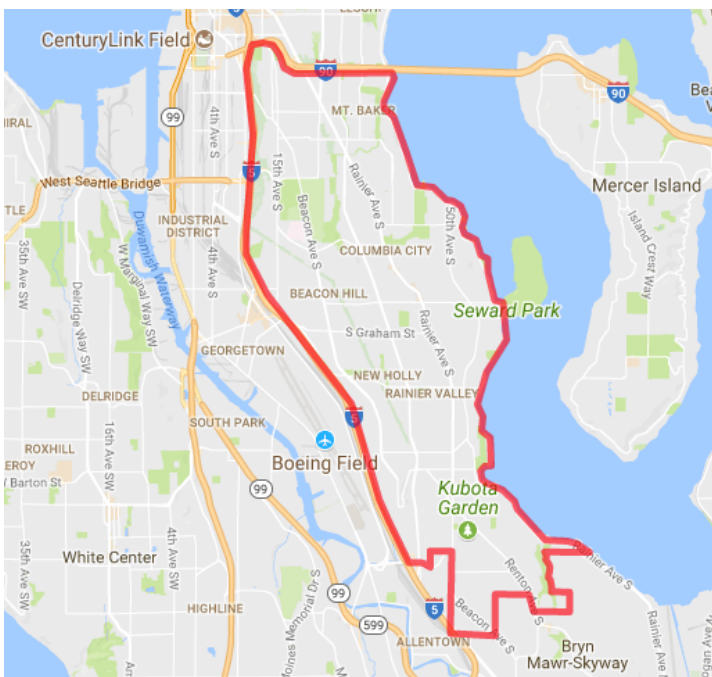
